Abstract: This document presents the instructions needed to prepare the extended abstract to be included in the proceedings of the FEMIB 2022. All extended abstracts should be written in English. In order to achieve graphical consistency, the extended abstract should be preferably written using Microsoft Word. It should start with the paper's title, authors, authors' affiliation, address and e-mail, followed by the Abstract's text and the keywords (up to six). Please, indicate the author making the presentation with an asterisk.

1 INTRODUCTION

The extended abstract should be written in MS Word format in single-spaced in 10-point Times New Roman. Do not indent the text paragraphs. Please, briefly explain the aim and scope of your study, your materials and methods, and the main conclusions of the study. Max 2 figures/photographs can be placed in the extended abstract. Authors are requested to submit extended abstracts (max 3 pages in the length) in electronic form (MS-Word) via the website conference system, PRIMORIS. The incorrect formats may result in your extended abstract being returned to you by e-mail. The scientific committee will select the contributions for oral or poster presentations.

A digital version of the FEMIB 2022 Proceedings (Smith and Jones, 2017) will be published and available for registered participants. You will have to submit your extended abstract via the PRIMORIS system. You will have the change to present your work as an oral OR a poster presentation (Smith and Jones, 2007). If the FEMIB 2022 scientific committee accepts your extended abstract as an oral or poster presentation, you will have the possibilities to submit a paper for the FEMIB 2022 proceedings or the published your work in a journal special issue.

The use of this document is mandatory for the preparation of the camera-ready. Please follow the instructions closely in order to make the volume look as uniform as possible (Brown et al., 2012).

Please remember that all the Extended Abstracts must be in English and without orthographic errors.

Do not add any text to the headers (do not set running heads) and footers, not even page numbers, because text will be added electronically.

For a best viewing experience the used font must be Times New Roman, on a Macintosh use the font named times.

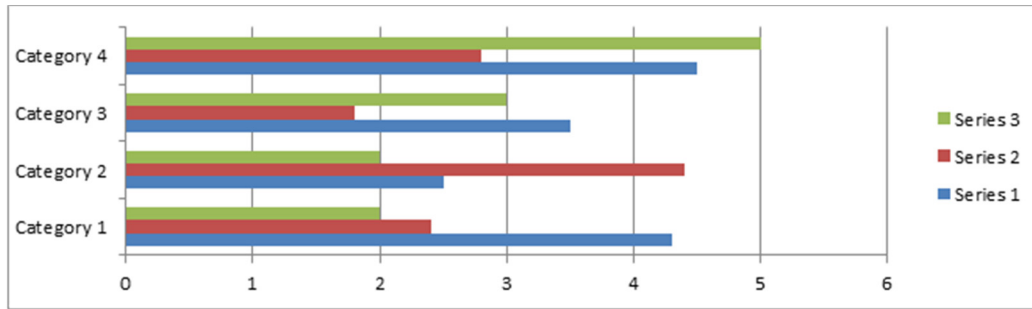


Figure 1: Example graph for the extended abstract.
